

Rules for grant of Maternity Leave to the female employees under the Academy - Modification - Orders issued. Sub:

The Executive Committee vide Resolution No. 43.9, v & vi has resolved to enhance the Maternity Leave for the female employees to 135 days and also resolved to sanction leave for miscarriage up to a maximum of 6 weeks with effect from 01.01.2006. In the circumstances orders are hereby issued enhancing the maternity leave of the regular female employees under CAPE to 135 days and introducing leave upto 6 weeks in cases of miscarriage including abortion, subject to production of medical certificate. The conditions prescribed earlier for granting maternity leave will stand. Director, CAPE will authority for sanctioning such leave.

These orders will come into force with effect from 01.01.2006.


Sub: CAPE-Estt- Employees of CAPE keeping of Service Books reg

CAPE - Service Rules - Certain additions and amendments to leave rules -Sub: Orders issued.

While introducing the Service Rules of CAPE with effect from 01.01.2005 the rules for granting various kinds of leave to the regular employees were incorporated under Item No. 7 of Part II of the said service rules. On further examination, certain modifications and additions to the leave rules were found necessary. Therefore the matter had been placed before the Executive Committee at its 43rd meeting held on 23.12.2005 and the Committee vide Resolution No. 43.9 had decided to introduce the following modifications and additions to the CAPE Service Rules.

Leave Without Allowances (New Rule 7- e) (i)

All regular employees, both vacation and non-vacation, may be sanctioned LWA subject to the following conditions.

- 1. LWA will be granted only on genuine grounds, provided there is no other leave at his/her-credit and the sanctioning authority is convinced of the necessity for the leave and that the functioning of the concerned section/institution is not adversely affected.
- The maximum number of days of LWA is limited to 60 days.
- 3. The Director, CAPE will be the authority for sanctioning such leave. Applications for LWA should be forwarded to the Director for sanction, with the specific recommendations of the head of the institution

(ii) Earned leave for Part-time contingent employees (New Rule 7- f)

Part-time contingent employees shall be eligible for earned leave @ one day for every 44 days of service and such earned leave shall not accumulate beyond 30 days. They are also eligible for surrender of earned leave subject to a maximum of 5 days in a financial year. The Director, CAPE shall be the authority for sanctioning the surrender leave.

(iii) Leave for vacation staff

Para 7 (c) (iii) of the Part II General rules of CAPE service rules is amended as follows:

(iii) In addition to the vacation, they shall also be eligible for half pay leave at the rate of one day for 22 days of service, per every completed calendar year of service which shall be granted only after completion of each year of service. Maximum half pay leave that can accumulate shall be limited to 60 days. Salary payable during half pay leave shall be half the basic pay and allowances admissible for such half-pay.

Other paras under 7(c) will remain unchanged.

These additions/amendments will take effect from 01.01.2006.

Sub: CAPE - Service Rules - Certain additions and amendments to leave rules - Orders issued.

While introducing the Service Rules of CAPE with effect from 01.01.2005 the rules for granting various kinds of leave to the regular employees were incorporated under Item No. 7 of Part II of the said service rules. On further examination, certain modifications and additions to the leave rules were found necessary. Therefore the matter had been placed before the Executive Committee at its 58th meeting held on 18.10.2007 and the Committee vide Resolution No. 58.15 had decided to introduce the following modifications and additions to the CAPE Service Rules.

1) Casual Leave

The number of casual leave allowable to vacation staff shall be increased to 15 days and that of non-vacation staff be increased to 20 days per year,

2) Half-pay-leave

The number of half-pay-leave to which an employee of CAPE is eligible shall be fixed at 20 days per year.

3) Earned Leave

The number of earned leave that will accrue to an employee shall be fixed at 1/11 days of the period of service after declaration of probation.

4) Surrender of Earned leave

There will be no change in the existing rules with regards to the surrender of earned leave.

These additions/amendments will take effect from 16.11,2007





Sub: Special maternity leave to female contract employees' unification Regarding

Ref:- 1. Circular No. 18/2009 dtd 28.09.209 of the Director, CAPE. 2. E3-6992/2009/CMC//5678 dtd 04.08.2009, 29.09.2009

With reference to the above, the following clarifications are issued regarding the sanction of special maternity allowance to female contract employees.

- Whether contract employees can be granted leave for 2 months during maternity period as they are receiving special maternity allowance, they cannot be treated as absentees.
- Whether those whose termination date comes during maternity period will be entitled to get their term of appointment extended automatically.
- Whether the absence of such employees over and above the period of 2 months can be regularized by granting LWA
- Whether the maternity leave can be granted to such employees by the Head of Institutions as is being done in the case of regular employees irrespective of special maternity leave.

Yes

No. They shall be entitled to draw maternity allowance till the contract period is valid

No. There is no provision to sanction LWA to contract employees. However extension of contract period can be cc dered after the maternity period.

They are not entitled to maternity leave. Instead they will be paid maternity allowance till the expiry of two months or till the end of the contract period whichever is earlier. Payment of maternity allowance can be granted by the Head of Institutions.

Any such cases noticed hereafter, will be viewed seriously.

Please ensure that the above instructions are strictly carried out. In any circumstances, appointments are to be made urgently. Head of Institutions can appraise the position to the Director and detailed permission. In such cases, the list and Bio data of the persons to be appointed may be submitted to this office for approval.



ORDER

In G.O(P) 389/2010/H.Edn dated 07.12.2010, Government have issued orders for implementing the revised AICTE scheme for the teaching staff of Engineering Colleges under State Government. As per proceedings No. E1-318/2011/CAPE dated 23.02.2011, orders have been issued to implement the pay revision in CAPE as per the AICTE Scheme, subject to certain conditions. In the said order, it was ordered, interalia that declaring/ re-designating of existing Assistant Professors as Associate Professors and Professors will be done by CAPE Director separally considering qualification, length of service seniority etc as per AICTE/Government norms.

- 2. As resolved by the Executive Committee in its 118th meeting held on 14.06.2011, a Committee was constituted to scrutinize the proposals for re-designation and to submit their recommendations, in terms of AICTE norms and State Government The Committee (Dr. Shaji Senadipan, Principal, College of Engineering, Perumon, Shri. Saji. A.J, Principal, College of Engineering and Management, Punnapra and Shri. Ramachandran V.V. Administrative Officer, CAPE) submitted their report. Their main recommendations as per the terms of reference are
 - (i) Assistant Professors with 3 years of service in that post as on 01.01.2011 re-designated as Associate Professors in the pay band of Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000. For fixation of their pay, the Table No. 4 in the Government Order dated 07.12.2010 will be made applicable.
 - (ii) The 5 incumbent Assistant Professors who have not completed 3 years as on 1.1.2011 in that post, may be ordered to be continued in the same designation until they are placed in the pay band of Rs. 37,400-67000 and may re-designate as Associate Professors on completion of 3 years of service.

- (iii) 16 incumbent Lecturers have applied for the post of Associate Professors. The Committee is of opinion that none of them are qualified to be placed to the post of Associate Professors as per the existing CAPE order.
- The matter was examined in consultation with the Dean, CAPE and following orders are issued.
- 4. The following incumbent Assistant Professors in the Pre-revised scale of Pay of Rs. 12000-18300 are re-designated as Associate Professors in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 9000/- with effect from 01.01.2011. Their pay will notionally be fixed with effect from 01.01.2011 as per Table No. 4 in G.O (P)389/2010/H.Edn dated 07.12.2010 and monetary benefit will be from the date of their lbis order.
